Our learning experience:

Our learning experience is 'A Superhero Like You'. We will learn about emergency services and other heroes in the community who help us. Throughout this learning experience, the children will be learning about police officers, fire fighters, crossing patrol officers and paramedics. We will meet some different people who help us during this topic. The children will also learn about the character values of heroes.



English:

This term, the children will learn about syllables in words and initial sounds in words. We will be reading a variety of stories. Some of the stories we are reading are: A Superhero Like You by Dr Ranj and Supertato by Sue Hendra. It is important to us that children develop a love of reading and we will be encouraging that through the use of diverse, high-quality texts and daily storytelling.

Maths:

In Maths, we will start to learn about numbers to 10. We will practise counting objects and pictures to ten. The children will also learn about positional language and exploring language related to size.

Understanding the World:

We will learning about different occupations and jobs in the community. The children will meet a range of people from different occupations. They will have the opportunity to red books and stories about different emergency services. We will learn about how things work and the different forces they can feel.

Expressive Arts and Design:

The children will practise different techniques to make marks, draw and paint and will have the opportunity to use different media and materials, such as, crayons, chalk and charcoal. They will also have the opportunity to make emergency services vehicles for our exhibition at the end of the term.

The children will continue to develop the prime areas of personal, social and emotional development, communication and language and physical development through their play and taught sessions.
