Our topic:

The theme for our Spring Term topic is, 'A place of invention,, imagination and discovery'. This aims to develop the children's understanding of some of the biomes in the world by discovering the characteristics, location and animals found in these places. At the end of this topic, the children will showcase their learning by taking part in an exhibition.

English: The children will experience writing in role using the high quality texts "Once Upon a Raindrop" and 'Rhythm of the Rain", writing, including a poem, explanation text, and a recount.

Maths: This term, we will be focusing on multiplication and division; concentrating on the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. Alongside this we will look at length, money and fractions.

Science: This term, we will be working scientifically to find out about plants and living things and their habitats. We will be linking this to our topic by looking at how plants and animals are adapted to suit different environments. We will be exploring and using classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.

History and Geography: Our topic will focus on some of the world's biomes. Early in the term we will visit the Botanical Gardens, focusing on the biome of a rainforest. Throughout the topic, children will discover the characteristics of a range of biomes across the world, locating and naming them and also starting to look at the impact the world is having on them.

PE: During this term, the children will be working on their fitness and improving their skills such as agility, speed, and co-ordination. We will be improving ball skills by developing our confidence and accuracy when throwing, catching and kicking a ball. We will be using the skills developed in the first half of the term and implement them into learning how to play games of handball and dodgeball.

Art: Throughout this term, the children will be learning the skills of photography to create their own landscape picture in the style of Henri Rousseau

Computing: In our computing lessons this term, the children will be learning to understand computer networks, to use search technologies such as 'Google' safely, to select, use, and combine a variety of software, and to use technology respectfully and responsibly

RE: In RE, this term we will be looking at the Holy Bible and Loss and Change.

French: In French the children will be learning to describe what we can do and the vocabulary to describe animals.

DT As part of this subject children will be given the chance to plan, design, make and evaluate a rainforest menu. Then run their very own café.
