Word Parts Write your words. Then use a coloured pencil to divide the words into syllables. e.g. jumping caterpillar	Write all of your spelling words in alphabetical (ABC) order.	Write your words using one colour for the vowels and another colour for the consonants. (vowels: a, e, i, o, u)
Bubble Letters Write your spelling words out in bubble writing.	Rainbow Words Write your spelling words with coloured pencils. Make each letter a different colour.	"Ransom" Words "Write" your words by cutting letters out of a newspaper or magazine and gluing the letters on a piece of paper to spell your words.
Scrambled Words Write your words. Then write them again with the letters mixed up. Can you unscramble them again the next day? e.g. watch - cwhta	Silly Sentences Write 3 or more sentences that use all your spelling words.	Word Search Create your own word search with your spellings. Show the answers to your puzzle in a different colour.
