| Word Parts | ABC Order | Vowel Spotlight |

| Write your words. Then use a coloured pencil to divide the words into syllables. e.g. jumping caterpillar | Write all of your spelling words in alphabetical (ABC) order. | Write your words using one colour for the vowels and another colour for the consonants. (vowels: a, e, i, o, u) |
| Bubble Letters | Rainbow Words | "Ransom" Words |
| Write your spelling words out in bubble writing. | Write your spelling words with coloured pencils. Make each letter a different colour. | "Write" your words by cutting letters out of a newspaper or magazine and gluing the letters on a piece of paper to spell your words. |
| Scrambled Words | Silly Sentences | Word Search |
| Write your words. Then write them again with the letters mixed up. Can you unscramble them again the next day? e.g. watch - cwhta | Write 3 or more sentences that use all your spelling words. | Create your own word search with your spellings. Show the answers to your puzzle in a different colour. |
